

XI FUNDING FOR REVITALIZATION AND NEW CLUB BUILDING

(Renumbered August 2010)

- A. An amount of up to, not to exceed \$750, may be awarded as an incentive to a forming new club. This amount to be disbursed from the Revitalization/New Club Fund as follows: \$250 with the submission of the geographical information. Another \$250 upon the paid dues of 14 affiliate members. The last \$250 upon the setting of the date for the chartering of the new club. This amount is to be given to the organizing club, and/or District Eleven member who is fulfilling the policy set forth in the Altrusa International, Inc. ByLaws, Policy 20 and is to be used in the expenses of forming club. If the club does not reach a charter, no monies need to be returned.

- B. Expenses in conjunction with the groundwork for establishing new clubs in District Eleven shall be reimbursed by District Eleven from the Revitalization/New Club Building Fund. These expenses shall include but not be limited to: postage, phone calls, printing/copying, overnight stays in the area, transportation (mileage or airfare), room rentals for meetings and follow-up with forming a new club. Expenses are to be paid according to the District Policies for District Officers/Chairmen doing district business. (Section X fully revised 1/30/2010).
